

## **Citizen Concerns About Turnpike Construction Issues Quickly Resolved**

The Eastern Extension of the President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT), now under construction from Firewheel Parkway to IH-30, will provide mobility solutions for neighborhoods, business districts, school zones and streets along its 9.9 mile length. The Extension is scheduled to open to traffic in late 2011.

The North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) recognizes the need to minimize impacts from the Eastern Extension construction as much as possible and respond quickly when concerns arise.
