

The City of Rowlett's Fireworks on Main is an event you won't want to miss. Celebrate freedom with friends and family as you enjoy live music and fireworks. Bring the entire family down to Main Street for an event you will not want to miss!

**Where is the best viewing spot for the fireworks?**

The fireworks display is a unique low level display being fired from the field directly behind the library, therefore the best location to see the show is in the immediate downtown area.

**What kind of seating is available?**

Please plan on bringing a blanket or chair for seating. Seating will be available on Main Street, the grass area in front of the library, and any other open areas on or around Main Street.

Parking is available at Coyle Middle School, Herfurth Park, along Coyle Street, and at First Baptist Church and First Methodist Church on Main Street.
